NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 1st day of July, 2019, at 10:00 a.m., at the Middle Snake Tamarac Rivers Watershed District located in Warren, Minnesota, a public hearing will be held regarding a pending petition which was filed with the Board of Managers of the Middle Snake Tamarac Rivers Watershed District requesting that certain lands, more fully described in said petition, be added to the benefited area of Judicial Ditch #17.

Said petition and other documents concerning this matter are available for inspection at the office of the Middle Snake Tamarac Rivers Watershed District, at 453 North McKinley Street, in Warren, Minnesota.

All parties interested in the petition or who are affected by said petition are invited to appear before the Middle Snake Tamarac Rivers Watershed District Board of Managers at said time and place to present their objections, if any, and show cause why an order should not be made by the Board of Managers of the Middle Snake Tamarac Rivers Watershed District granting the addition of land to Judicial Ditch #17 as described in said petition.




Dear Mr. Roger Mischel,
