## ENGINEERS REPORT TO THE BOARD OF MANAGERS OF THE MIDDLE RIVER SNAKE RIVER WATERSHED DISTRICT

BACKGROUND REPORT
MARSHALL COUNTY DITCH #39

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## A) INTRODUCTION




Figure 1 County Ditch #39, Benefited Area From Auditors Tabular Statement 1948

This report concerning County Ditch #39 is prepared under the direction of the Board of Managers of the Middle River-Snake River Watershed District. The intent of this report is to provide information needed by the Board to manage this system. The information presented here is summary of the information concerning County Ditch #39 as it existed prior to the Board of Managers obtaining jurisdiction of this system on December 20, 1983. The location of the drainage system and the area found to be benefited is shown in figure 1.



- 2) "Order Appointing Engineer", County Ditch #39, filed with the County Auditor (not dated);
- "Order Directing Engineer to Make Detailed Survey", County Ditch #39, filed with the County Auditor May 10, 1948;
- 4) "Engineers Final Report", County Ditch #39, filed with the County Auditor June 22, 1948;
- 5) "Viewers Report", County Ditch #39, filed with the County Auditor July 31, 1948;
- 6) "Plan Profile of the Extension to County Ditch #39", prepared in 1948, filed with the Marshall County Highway Department
- 7) "Order Establishing Ditch", County Ditch #39, filed with the County Auditor on August 31, 1948;
- 8) "Auditors Tabular Assessment Statement" for the construction of County Ditch #39, filed with the County Auditor on December 24, 1948;

No "as built" plan was found which shows County Ditch #39 as it was established. The information presented here was assembled from the available sources and is intended to document the original construction as much as possible. If questions arise about the accuracy of the data it will be necessary to consult the original sources.

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Marshall County Ditch #39 was established by order of the Marshall County Commissioners on August 31, 1948. The drainage system as it was established consists of a main channel approximately 7,000 feet (1.3 miles) and an extension approximately 6,000 feet (1.1 miles) long. The drainage system originates 1 mile east, and 5.7 miles north of the Village of Oslo. The ditch outlets into the Red River of the North. The location of County Ditch #39 is shown in Figure 2.

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From the Engineers Report it appears that at least 2 crossings were established on the Main and at least 5 crossings were established on the Extension. In addition, at least 1 inlet culvert was installed. The planned locations of the crossings on the Main are shown on the plan on file with the County Auditor. The planned location of the crossings on the Extension are given on the profile sheets on file with the County Highway Department. The planned locations and culvert sizes of all the crossings are given in table 9.

All of this system is within the boundary of the Middle River-Snake River Watershed District.
