That the Engineer's report and the Viewer's report for the above-described project has been filed with the Board of Managers of the Middle River-Snake River Watershed District and are available for inspection at the Middle River-Snake River Watershed District office at 453 North McKinley Street in Warren, Minnesota.

All parties interested in the above-described project are hereby invited to appear before the Board of Managers at said time and place and present their objections, if any, and show cause why orders should not be made confirming the reports of the Engineer and Viewers.
