# PETITION FOR PUBLIC DITCH.

To the ~~County Board~~ <sup>District Court</sup> of the County of Polk State of Minnesota:

The undersigned owners of lands over which the ditch hereinafter described pass would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare and the reclamation of wet and overflowed lands require the establishment and construction of a ditch along the following described route in the Town of Higdem in said County of Polk

and that the construction of the same will be of public benefit and utility and will promote the public health, and is necessary for the following reasons, to-wit:

That said ditch will reclaim large areas of overflowed lands and will permit the construction of roads in said township and will relieve the public health from the menace of stagnant water.

*A general description of the proposed starting point, route, and terminus of said ditch is as follows:*

Commencing at a point 1083 feet easterly and 23 feet southerly from the one quarter section corner between sections 28 and 33, township 154, north of range 50, being the township of Higdem, thence westerly parallel with said section line through section 33 and 32 to the Red River of the North
