RESOLUTION TO REDETERMINE THE
BENEFITS FOR JUDICIAL DITCH NO. 39

WHEREAS, it appears that the original benefits determined in the proceeding to establish County Ditch No. 39 over which system the Middle River-Snake River Watershed District has jurisdiction do not reflect reasonable present day land values and/or the benefitted areas have changed:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Managers of the Middle River-Snake River Watershed District, as follows:

1. That the benefits and damages of County Ditch No. 39 shall be redetermined in accordance with the provisions of M.S. 106A.351.
2. That the following individuals are hereby appointed as viewers to redetermine benefits and damages and report thereon to the Watershed Board.
Henry Gredvig-Crookston, MN
Selmer Sorter-Middle River, MN
Joe Toren-Middle River, MN
3. That the Watershed District Engineer shall prepare a plan for the planting of the drainage system spoil banks in grass to a width of 16.5 ft. as required by statute and the viewers are directed to take into consideration the Engineer's Report in their redetermining the damages and benefits.
4. That a public hearing shall be held on the reports of the Engineer and viewers after they have been filed with the District preceded by notice as required by law.
